

COURSES FOR FOOTWEAR DESIGNERS, MODEL MAKERS and TECHNICIANS

School for Footwear Model Makers and Technicians has provided diploma courses since 1923 to prepare young people to become designers, model makers and shoe production technicians.

The Basic courses last for two years (240 hours/year), are divided in three sections: women, men and sports/technical, and they lay the foundations for becoming Shoe Model Makers.

The Specialisation courses last for one year (240 hours/year), are divided in three sections: creative model maker (designer), technical model maker (engineering manager) and they prepare students to face problems involved with designing a Collection (Creative area) and organising and managing production (Technical area).

The New Technology courses last one year and are divided in courses of CAD-CAM, Computer Graphics and Computer Systems; the courses are characterised by the use of the most recent computer systems in the shoe industry for designing shoe models and for managing data and images.

Subjects and Teaching Methodology: design, technical design, graphic, CAD-CAM systems, Computer Graphics and Systems CAD, Information Technology.

The School activities include permanent training initiatives for young diploma holders and seminars for young entrepreneurs working alongside Professional and Technical Institutes to train young people for careers in the shoe industry.

The shoes have been realized in collaboration with the students attending the Course for Shoe Designers (3rd Year) at the Politecnico Calzaturiero Veneto and with the support of the following companies:

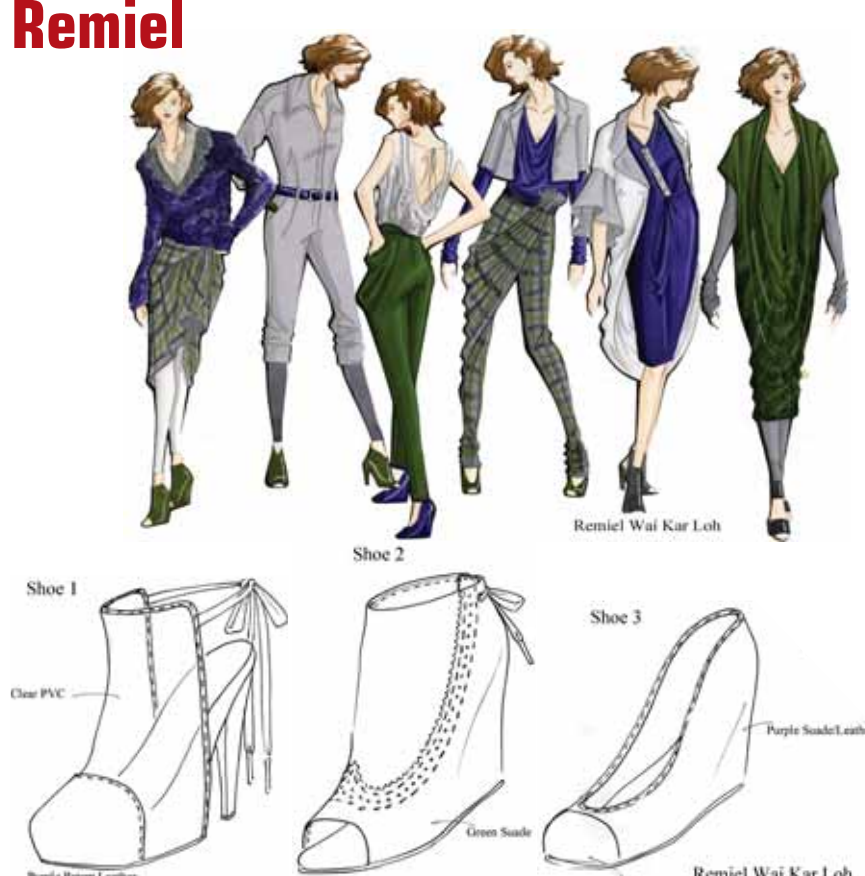
